CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Here's a construction update from our contractor, Bovis Lend Lease.

Excavation activities have begun to bring the land to the elevations required for the structural foundation work. This will lead into our first concrete footing activities toward the end of month/beginning of next month. Other activities include:

- ComEd placed incoming service lines from Keslinger road to the property.
- Perimeter site safety/security fence and field office trailers were installed.
- Planning and construction began on temporary construction entrance off of Keslinger.
- Sewer/Water underground utility tie-ins are in the works.

What we know about life is that one of the most important things that can happen to us is having the opportunity to create and nurture good relationships with our families, colleagues and friends.

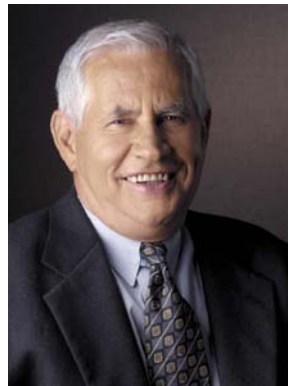
